

ENDLINER REPLACEMENT PROCEDURES

On front endliners it is easier if you remove the front lounge. If the pivot bracket is removed from one end the other end will slide out so the lounge can be set back out of the way.

Next remove the curtains, rooflocker face frame, entertainment center, reading lights and upper window trim.

Now score (or cut) the endliner with a box knife up and over the top of the rooflocker and above the curved windows. It is actually easier just to score it, then the plastic can be ripped out along this line.

When removing the old endliner you removed a strip of inside skin just above the center window. Pop rivet this back in place above the window so it covers the space between the window frame and upper window bow.

To allow the new trim to lay a little flatter around the ceiling we pull off the plastic trim around the ceiling with a pair of pliers. Don't bother drilling out rivets, just yank it out.

If you are working on a rear endliner with twin beds the overhead rooflockers may extend over part of the endliner. We remove just the end of the locker then reposition it after the new endliner is installed.

To install the new "J" extrusion measure from the edge of the inside skin back 1 1/4" and mark lightly with a pencil about every foot clear around the ceiling.
